Equality & Diversity Policy

- 3. Recognise and adopt the Sport England definition of Sports Equity*.
- Ensure that everyone has the right to enjoy their exercise, sports and social
 activities in an environment free from the threat of discrimination, intimidation,
 harassment and abuse.
- 5. Endeavour to ensure that all members, hired personnel and volunteers challenge discriminatory behaviour and promote equality of opportunity.
- 6. Deal with any incidents of discriminatory behaviour seriously and where appropriate report these to relevant authorities.

It is about changing the culture and structure of sport to ensure that it becomes equally accessible to all members of society, whatever their age, ability, gender, race, ethnicity, sexuality or socio-economic status.
